

RoHS: the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances

EEE: Electrical and Electronic Equipment

WEEE Directive: the Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment

that leads to the collection, disposal and recycling of said equipment.

The EU Directive 2002/95/EC implemented on 1 July, 2006 bans or restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in new electrical and electronic equipment in the European market. The directive is aimed to reduce, eliminate or find alternatives to the following substances of no more than allowable maximum concentration (parts per million) levels of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants.

RoHS Regulations only apply to EEE Categories 1 through 10, none which are applicable to Stride Tool Products.

Stride Tool products do not require electrical current or magnetic current to function therefore

Stride Tools products are outside the scope of the ROHS Regulations.

Stride Tool products, to our knowledge, are NOT in or contained in any (new) electrical and electronic equipment.
